PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Responsible for mobile MRI unit operation and execution of the screening MRI studies according to established research and imaging protocols.
- Self-directed screening study acquisition including assuring the safety of study pediatric participants, the clinical quality of the acquired images, imaging data back-up and transmission, and record keeping for the studies and system QC.
- Monitors imaging equipment condition and engages technical service providers as needed for troubleshooting to assure availability of imaging assets to avoid interruption of screening workflow.
- Responsible for the mobile MRI unit wherever deployed to school campuses or other locations where the screening studies are done.
