**POSITION SUMMARY**

The student worker assists lab staff with routine tasks related to daily operations. Depending on the assigned department, duties may include clerical support, data collection and recording, supply retrieval, and (for positions in laboratories) assistance during laboratory procedures.

**PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Provides assistance to department staff for routine tasks, including data collection and recording, filing and running errands; 50%
- If assigned, performs tasks that will require specialized instruction, which will be provided; 25%
- For positions in research laboratories: Performs basic laboratory blood tests, helps with lab set-up for procedures and clean-up; for positions in non-laboratory departments: provides additional assistance such as answering phones and organizing materials; 25%

**QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS**

- High School/GED is required
- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must be able to demonstrate verbal understanding of the nature of preclinical animal research
- Experience in a medical setting is preferred
- Working knowledge of Word, Excel, and PowerPoint is preferred
