STUDY PARTICIPATION OPPORTUNITY

Prevention of Aortic Stenosis Progression Research Study



Texas Heart Institute is seeking volunteers with mild or moderate Aortic Stenosis, ages 35 or older without diabetes to participate in a research study. The purpose of this study is to determine if Evogliptin is effective in delaying the progression of Aortic Stenosis.

You may be eligible to participate if you:

- Are 35 years old or older.
- have mild or moderate Aortic Stenosis
- · Do NOT have diabetes.

Study participation

Participation will last for 2 years and 2 months and includes 4 in-person study visits and 8 virtual visits. We will ask you to

undergo a blood draw, echocardiogram, cardiac CT, and take a study medication for 2 years. You will be compensated for your time spent in this study.

Will I benefit from participating in this study?

Participating in this study may slow down the rate of your aortic valve disease progression and may delay the need for aortic valve replacement.
